1. DECLARATION OF OPENING / ANNOUNCEMENT OF VISITORS

4. ELECTION OF SHIRE PRESIDENT

The Chief Executive Officer called for nominations for the office of Shire President. Two nominations were received, nominating Cr Pollard and Cr Slater, therefore an election by secret ballot was conducted.

The Chief Executive Officer and Executive Officer left the chambers to conduct the count at 7.15pm.

The Chief Executive Officer and Executive Officer re-entered the chambers at 7.15pm. The CEO declared that with an Absolute Majority of the votes, Cr Pollard was elected as Shire President for a term of two years.

Cr Pollard read aloud the Declaration of Office of Shire President witnessed by the Chief Executive Officer, Ms Linda Gray as an Authorised Person to receive the Declaration.
