4. General Business

Cr Denton raised a road issue on behalf of a ratepayer in the community.

- Grantham Street, also known as the Northern 2 Mile, has seen a huge number of possible unauthorised trucks using the road, coming off Albany Highway into Cranbrook Town. The concern of the ratepayer is that this road is not a RAV approved road for large trucks, but still sees a large number of trucks using it, and driving at speeds in excess of the limits. There is no signage posted. The resident is also concerned about the vibrations these trucks emit potentially causing damage to property.
